

7 day starting protocol for Show Pigs

Start your pigs on this program on first day you pick them up

- Administer orally or mix with feed a minimum of 30 minutes before activity, 1 hour works best.
- This product works for an average of 10 hours and takes a minimum of 30 minutes to kick in.
- Increase/decrease dosage as needed depending on the animal's temperament. (Every Pig is different)

Using the protocol below will help get your animals settled in to your barn and on feed and water while helping them overcome the stress of a new environment.

Training

- Use 10-20 mls. 30 minutes prior to a training session. Increase/decrease dosage as needed depending on the animal's temperament
- Training session can be as simple as a 5-10 minute walk, a quick trip across the scales or a quick rinse in the wash rack.

<u>Shipping</u>

• Give 10-20 mls. 30 minutes prior to loading to ship to new location.

<u>Jackpot</u>

- Give 10-20 mls. 30 minutes prior to loading.
- Once arriving at show, give 10 mls. (or more if needed) depending on your animals temperament.
- You should have a very calm and happy pig for the ride and duration of the show.

Multi-Day Show

- Start 5 days out from show with 10 mls. AM/PM
- Give 10 mls. 30 minutes prior to loading.
- Give 10 mls. or dialed in dosage AM & PM daily throughout the show.
- Increase/decrease dosage as needed depending on the animal's temperament once at show.
- This regimen should help keep your pig on feed, and help keep immune system up due to stress reduction as well as help them thru the stressful events of the show itself.
